

Sequoia Hills Stables Equipment List for Summer Camp

Below is a list of suggested equipment and apparel for Summer Riding Camp:

- 1. One pair of riding boots or paddock boots that have at least a ¼ inch flat heel.
- 2. All students are required to wear a riding helmet, meeting ASTM/SEI standards. Some helmets are available to borrow if need be. New helmets can be purchased locally.
- 3. Students should wear long jeans, riding tights or breeches for riding and any shirt that is not sleeveless. Short sleeves are OK.
- 4. Knee-hi socks are recommended to avoid chafing from the stirrup leathers.
- 5. Students should bring a water bottle with their name on it. Fresh, cold water will be available.
- 6. Sunscreen is highly recommended, as well as a hat with a visor for when they are not riding.
